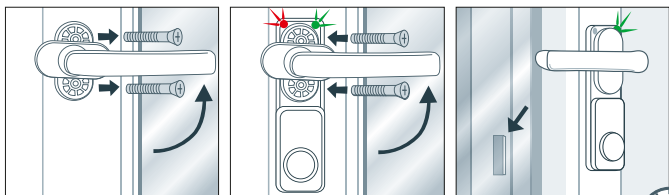


The window alarm is installed directly on the handle. It reliably detects when the window or window door is opened by force by being levered out and reacts to this with a red signal light and a loud alarm which frightens off the burglars and alerts you.

The window alarm can be installed without great effort or tools. It is fixed to the removed handle and screwed back in place on the window vent together with the handle. The accompanying magnetic contact is simply bonded to the inside of the frame. Straightaway, you have made your home more secure in no time at all.

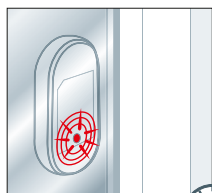
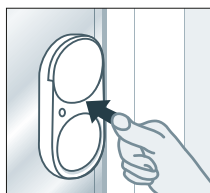
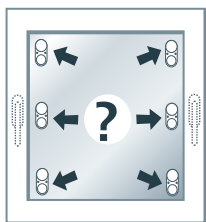
Schüco glass breakage alarm



The glass breakage alarm detects vibrations in the window panes. If the glass is struck with force, the glass breakage alarm emits a loud alarm sound. This intimidates the thief, who abandons the attempted break-in out of fear of being discovered.

Maximum security – discreet appearance

The glass breakage alarm can be positioned unobtrusively in the window by simply being bonded to the window glass. For small surfaces up to 2 m², one glass breakage alarm is sufficient. If the glass surface is larger than 2 m², you should use two alarms to achieve maximum security. As soon as the batteries are inserted, the glass breakage alarm is ready to use. An LED on the reverse side, which can be deactivated, indicates that the glass breakage alarm is on standby.
